
# Law Links Internship 2006

It all started with nearly 100 applications to the 2006 Law Links Internship. Through a competitive and highly selective process, thirty-two juniors and seniors from Maryland high schools were offered internships with legal agencies, judges, nonprofit organizations and private law firms throughout Baltimore City, Worcester, Wicomico and Somerset Counties.

The 2006 Law Links Internship marks the 12th anniversary of the program. Since 1994, five hundred and eighty-three students have been offered opportunities to work in the legal profession. Five hundred and thirty-nine interns have successfully completed the internship, and are proof of the tremendous amount of planning, coaching, supervising and hard work that goes into Law Links each year.
