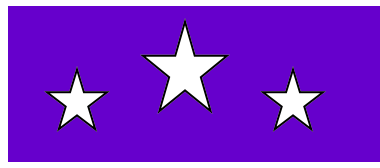
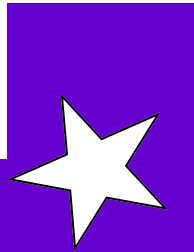
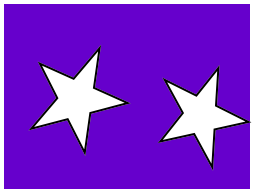
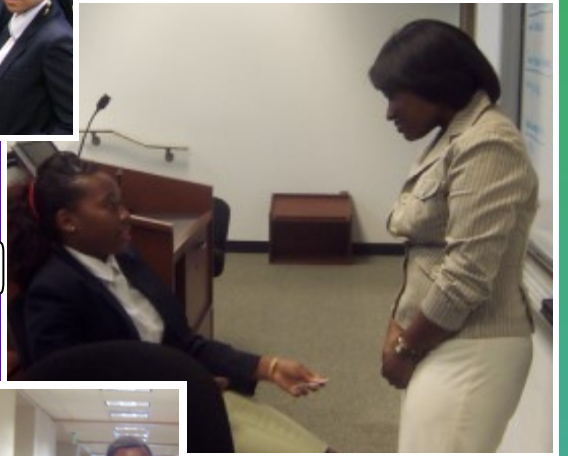
Students were often studying or jotting down notes on all the information they were given. The interns took advantage of the Institute's information, networking and resources to succeed even after Law Links was done.


